## **I TESTED POSITIVE FOR COVID-19. WHAT SHOULD I DO?**

- Rest and recover in your room until all of the following criteria have been met:
  - Significant improvement of symptoms, AND fever-free for at least 24 hours without fever-reducing medications.
  - A fever is measured by a temperature of 100.4 degrees F (38 degrees C) or higher.
- You should wear a mask around others while resting and recovering.
- Once the above criteria have been met, you should continue to wear a mask around others for five days.

## WHERE SHOULD I REST AND RECOVER?

- You should isolate in your own room. If you have a roommate, inform them of your status.
- Wear a mask at all times when around others, and distance yourself when possible.
